Harry Charlton 1936 – 2022

Dad was born in 1936 at Spyknave Farm, Middleton-on-Leven. He was one of 11 children. His parents were farmers and all the children used to help on the farm. Getting up early to help with the animals before going to school and also helping after school. He went to Hutton Rudby School and then on to Yarm. He served as a joiner then after qualifying worked for Spence Brothers for 8 years.

He married our mum in 1958 and they had 3 children, Julie, Jenny and Mark. They lived in Hutton Rudby for 2 years before moving to Broughton in 1960. During this time, he worked on a number of big projects in the area: the new dock in Middlesbrough; the 3 golf balls at Fylingdales; Ferrybridge power station; new bridges on the A1 by pass; Nylon 7 at Wilton; the new hotel at Middleton St George airfield.

He started up in business by himself in 1966. Restoring properties in and around Broughton. We all went to Australia for 2 years in 1971 as dad was in charge of building three towers of office blocks. After returning he built his own house and many others in the village. His greatest achievement was building the Lord Stones Café on the top of Carlton bank in 1981.

Dad has always followed horse racing and owned 3 race horse. Only one of them ever won: the horse was called Pergoda and won 9 times at Edinburgh. He was so proud. He loved living in the village and enjoyed his walks every morning and chatting to people. He enjoyed his pint on a night at the Jet Miners where he used to be a member of the darts and pool teams

He suddenly died on March 6th. He will be very sadly missed.

Harry's funeral took place on 4th April and his family would like to thank everyone for their kindness and support and for all the cards, letters and beautiful flowers that were received.
