

Living Streets

Have you seen the statistics on page 6?
Would anyone be interested in forming a Living Streets group in the villages?

Formally the Pedestrian Society, **Living Streets** has 60 local groups across the UK all dedicated to making walking easier and safer for everyone everywhere.

I am particularly concerned with the dangers faced by rural walkers on country roads where there is often a 60mph speed limit for vehicles, blind bends and no footpaths. However, we also face many of the difficulties common in urban areas too, such as lack of crossings and dropped kerbs, overhanging hedges, or cars parked on pavements that force us into the road.

Whatever the difficulty you may face with walking in your daily life Living Streets is there to try and help. Locally run campaigns have improved day to day life for many people nation wide.

The organisation not only offers support with advice and guidance in setting up the group, campaigning, and regular meetings, but also with its day to day running. There is also material assistance in the form of grants, a customised logo, posters, tee shirts and badges etc.

Two co-ordinators are required to start the group and organise whatever events the group wishes to run. Walking groups are a common feature as are stalls at local events to spread the word and recruit new members.
