

Our thanks to BT who have over the summer given our listed telephone kiosk a new coat of paint and a complete re-glaze so it is back to its former glory and looking very smart at the centre of the village.

There have been several burglaries in the area over the summer months, especially of equipment from farm outbuildings. If you see anything suspicious, i.e. people or vehicles in a strange place, please report this to the Police on 101, or 999 if the crime is actually being committed. The Police are also requesting households/businesses to register their CCTV cameras or video doorbells on their secure digital evidence management system, NICE Investigate. Visit www.northyorkshire.police/digital evidence for more information.

CAUTION SLOW down for Pedestrians and animals on roads. AND Keep pavements free of Obstruction

If your garden vegetation protrudes onto the pavement please cut it back to allow access for pushchairs and wheelchairs. Councils may serve notices to cut hedges to remove obstructions, and, if it isn't done, then do it themselves and charge the owner the

costs of cutting and clearing.



Similarly please ensure you don't park in a way which prevents pedestrian and wheelchair access along the footpath. This is an Obstruction which can result in a fixed penalty notice or fine from £50.00 to £130.00



A cyclist on Hill Road travelling at a fast speed nearly hit a pedestrian as he went through a narrow gap between the pedestrian and the hedge without giving any warning of his approach. When challenged and stopped he showed no remorse or understanding of his dangerous behaviour. He should read the Highway Code.

A car pulling a trailer with a Morris Minor on it passed a pedestrian at a fast speed and when told to slow down the driver said he was entitled to drive at the national speed limit on a narrow road without pavement, outside the 30MPH zone !!!!! Will someone, please, direct him to the Highway Code.

Please encourage people to behave sensibly before there is a serious accident.

Jim Watson 12/5/41 - 19/7/24

Jim was born and raised in Scotland before moving to Great Broughton with wife Ruth and daughter Carolyn in 1981.

The village community and the friendships made here meant a lot to Jim and Ruth, who would host parties at home and support various village events. While Ruth was typically more 'front of house', Jim was a generous host, especially with the measures when it came to the whisky cupboard at their home as evenings wore on.

Jim would often be found ferrying equipment and people around for village events or being on hand with bin bags at the end of the night during the myriad village hall or sports club events.

In retirement he volunteered with Community Cares, driving and maintaining minibuses and supporting new recruits.

Jim was always very active with various DIY and garden projects. In his younger days he'd also been a keen car enthusiast racing in rallies and sailing. Some may also remember him walking the family horse Thyme around the villages. Up until a couple of months before he died he was still taking his daily walks around the village. When Ruth was alive they enjoyed travelling to destinations around the world often with family or friends. They also enjoyed music with regular trips to concerts at the Sage or closer to home.

Having a long recovery from a broken leg in 2006, Jim got hooked on researching family history, recording this in meticulous detail. The bug bit hard and he was an active member of KGB history group researching families and properties in the villages. He supported others in their own work or research and in later years he also volunteered at the county archives. These activities only ending due to his recent health issues.

And while he was private, and therefore the extent of his illness took some by surprise, that twinkle in his eye and sense of humour were with him to the end, along with that softly spoken and sometimes unintelligible Scottish accent for those meeting him for the first time.

Carolyn, Dain and Joni would like to thank everyone for their kind messages, and the friends, neighbours and wonderful nursing teams who provided tremendous help and support to allow Jim to spend his remaining time in the comfort of his own home where he died peacefully in his sleep on 19 July.
